WHAT TO BRING:

Pencils with HB and H leads. I like the constant thickness mechanical pencils 0.7 thickness Pencil sharpener for non-mechanic pencils

Eraser (white plastic type recommended)

Eraser shield (important!)

Two large 45 degree plastic squares. 12" side length is best, 10" will do.

24" steel straight edge

Architect's triangular scale rule in imperial units (e.g. Staedler mars 987 18-31) NB, Architects, not Engineers.

Calculator with scientific functions

Pair of scissors

Pencil compass

One or two plastic templates for circles & ellipses

Note pad

Students who have them may bring:

Yacht curves

Planimeter
